A Peek at Our Weeks Math & Science

In math, we continue to work on fractions. This is one of the longest and hardest units we will do all year since fractions are a big part of the 5th grade math EOG. In particular, we will be focusing on multi-step word problems involving fractions.

In science, we are in the middle of our Forces and Motion unit. Students are learning about Sir Isaac Newton's 3 laws of motion. We made paper rockets and compared the distance they flew and why. This week, students are designing and building their own roller coasters. They will also be creating an advertisement for their coasters labeling each part with their force and motion vocabulary words. After break, we will learn about simple machines and distance vs. time graphs. Students should be studying their science vocabulary words from Ms. Gonzalez every week to every other week.

A Peek at Our Weeks Literacy

In literacy, we are heading into our Historical Fiction unit. Students will be able to see social studies, character traits, inferences, context clues and text structure all in the same unit! We are continuing to read nonfiction texts and focusing on how things such as characters, events, settings or ideas relate to each other. Please continue to work with your child on building their stamina. In 5th grade, vocabulary is essential. Make sure to help your child study their word sort words as well as their vocabulary words biweekly. Resources such as RAZkids.com and NewsELA.com are also ways that you and your child can work on making sure the 2nd quarter is a huge success!
